



**Instructions for enrollment in
JOUR 506: DIRECTED STUDIES IN JOURNALISM**

Course description: Undergraduate research project. Students must submit a written proposal to be approved by the instructor before enrollment. Limit of two hours enrollment in a student's total course work. Prerequisite: 2.5 grade point average overall and in Journalism.

Please note that this course is, essentially, a student research project graded by a member of the faculty. It is not an internship or any other kind of practicum.

1. In an attachment to this document, please submit a detailed, specific description of the subject and the method of reporting on the results of the Directed Study including proposed reference and research sources.
2. Student and faculty supervisor must sign below.
3. Obtain approval and signature of track head or associate dean below.
4. Submit completed form to Journalism Advising and Records Office in 201 Stauffer-Flint.
5. The Advising Office will give the student the instructor permission code or card.
6. The Advising Office will give copies of this completed form to student and faculty supervisor.
